A BILL

To require the Postal Service to establish a website providing information on post offices experiencing emergency suspensions, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Postal Suspension
- 5 Transparency Act".

1	SEC. 2. POST OFFICE EMERGENCY SUSPENSION WEBSITE.
2	(a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter VII of chapter 36 of
3	title 39, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
4	end the following new section:
5	"§ 3693. Post office emergency suspension website
6	"(a) In General.—The Postal Service shall develop
7	and maintain a publicly available website with an inter-
8	active web-tool that provides information about each cov-
9	ered post office, including the information described in
10	subsection (b).
11	"(b) Emergency Suspension Information.—The
12	information provided on the Website shall include—
13	"(1) a list of each covered post office; and
14	"(2) for each covered post office—
15	"(A) a street address;
16	"(B) the date on which the relevant emer-
17	gency suspension for such covered post office
18	took effect;
19	"(C) the reason for such emergency sus-
20	pension;
21	"(D) alternative services available, includ-
22	ing how to request curbside delivery;
23	"(E) the location of, and hours of oper-
24	ation for, the nearest facility providing retail
25	access to postal services; and

1	"(F) to the extent practicable, the esti-
2	mated date on which operations at such covered
3	post office will resume.
4	"(c) Address Search Functionality.—The
5	Website shall include functionality enabling a user to
6	search for information about covered post offices by street
7	address, ZIP Code, or post office box.
8	"(d) FORMAT.—The information described in sub-
9	section (a) shall be provided on the Website—
10	"(1) in a manner that—
11	"(A) presents such information on an
12	interactive dashboard;
13	"(B) is searchable and may be sorted and
14	filtered by the elements described in subsection
15	(b)(2); and
16	"(C) to the extent practicable, enables any
17	person or entity to download in bulk—
18	"(i) such information; and
19	"(ii) the results of a search by the ele-
20	ments described in subsection (b)(2);
21	"(2) in an open format that permits any indi-
22	vidual or entity to reuse and analyze such informa-
23	tion; and
24	"(3) in a structured data format, to the extent
25	practicable.

1	"(e) Suspension Notice.—Information provided on
2	the Website shall not be considered as providing notice
3	to any person that the operations of a post office have
4	been temporarily suspended pursuant to subchapter 61 of
5	the Postal Service Handbook PO-101, or any successor
6	policy.
7	"(f) Definitions.—In this section:
8	"(1) COVERED POST OFFICE.—The term 'cov-
9	ered post office' means a post office at which oper-
10	ations have been temporarily suspended pursuant to
11	subchapter 61 of the Postal Service Handbook PO-
12	101, or any successor policy.
13	"(2) Emergency suspension.—The term
14	'emergency suspension' means the temporary sus-
15	pension of operations at a post office pursuant to
16	subchapter 61 of the Postal Service Handbook PO-
17	101, or any successor policy.
18	"(3) Post office.—The term 'post office'
19	means a Post Office, as such term is defined in sec-
20	tion 241.1 of title 39, Code of Federal Regulations,
21	or any successor regulation, and includes a post of-
22	fice branch or post office station.
23	"(4) Website.—The term 'Website' means the
24	website described in subsection (a).".

- 1 (b) Implementation Deadline.—Not later than
- 2 one year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
- 3 Postal Service shall establish the website required under
- 4 section 3693(a) of title 39, United States Code, as added
- 5 by this Act.
- 6 (c) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 7 for chapter 36 of title 39, United States Code, is amended
- 8 by inserting after the item relating to section 3692 the
- 9 following new item:
