I am requesting funding for Garrison Crossing Housing in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Dover Housing Authority, located at 62 Whittier Street, Dover, NH 03820. The funding would be used for developing a mixed-use commercial and affordable housing project on 13.92 acres of City-owned land to build 116 apartments and 196 parking spaces, including 25 electric vehicle charging stations.
