A BILL

To establish the Northern Border Coordination Center, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Improving Coordina-

5 tion for the Northern Border Act".

6 SEC. 2. NORTHERN BORDER COORDINATION CENTER.

7 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than one year after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall
9 establish the Northern Border Coordination Center.

1 (b) PURPOSE.—The purpose of the Center shall be 2 to serve as the Department's forward deployed centralized 3 coordination center for operations, domain awareness, in-4 formation sharing, intelligence, training, and stakeholder 5 engagement with Federal, State, Tribal, local, and inter-6 national government partners along the northern border 7 of the United States. The Center shall be placed along the northern border at a location that is collocated with 8 9 an existing U.S. Border Patrol sector headquarters, Air 10 and Marine Operations branch, and United States Coast 11 Guard air station, and other facility at which Department 12 activities are carried out.

(c) FUNCTIONS.—The Center shall perform the functions described in this subsection in addition to any other
functions assigned by the Secretary.

16 (1) NORTHERN BORDER STRATEGY.—The Cen17 ter, in collaboration with relevant offices and compo18 nents of the Department, shall—

(A) serve as a coordination mechanism for
operational components for the implementation,
evaluation, and updating of the Northern Border Strategy and any successor strategy; and

(B) support the development of best practices and policies for personnel along the northern border to support such implementation.

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1	(2) TRAINING.—The Center shall serve as a
2	training location to support the delivery of training
3	or exercises for Department personnel and Federal,
4	State, Tribal, local, and international government
5	partners.
6	(d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
7	(1) CENTER.—The term "Center" means the
8	Northern Border Coordination Center established
9	pursuant to subsection (a).
10	(2) DEPARTMENT.—The term "Department"
11	means the Department of Homeland Security.
12	(3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
13	the Secretary of Homeland Security.
14	(e) LIMITATION.—The Center established pursuant
15	to subsection (a) shall be established separate and distinct
16	from the Secretary's authorities under section 708 of the
17	Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 348).
