Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for Newmarket Sewer Reliability Improvements Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Newmarket, located at 186 Main Street, Newmarket, NH 03857. The funding would be used for the design and construction of a new sewer forcemain in order to maintain reliable wastewater conveyance to the Town's treatment facility. The project would also make necessary upgrades to the Bay Road Pump Station as part of the sewer forcemain replacement.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it serves to replace a critical forcemain that has failed and upgrade the associated Bay Road Pump Station before another failure occurs in order to ensure continued protection of the Lamprey River and Great Bay ecosystems, as well as improve operational reliability of the municipal wastewater system.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq..
