I am requesting funding for Rye Fuel Island Replacement in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Rye, located at 10 Central Road Rye, NH 03870. The funding would be used for a replacement fuel station to safeguard clean drinking water and ensure reliable fuel for critical services that protect emergency services in the town and region.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because Rye's aging fuel station could contaminate the underlying aquifer, jeopardizing the community's drinking water. This investment protects public health, addresses environmental concerns, and ensures that the town is prepared to respond to local and regional emergencies which includes repairing critical infrastructure like roads, seawalls, bridges, and utilities.
