Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for Town of Conway Police Station Renovation and Expansion in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Conway, located at 35 East Conway Road, Center Conway NH 03813. The funding would be used to renovate and expand the town's police station, as demands have exceeded the building's available capacity and renovation are necessary to provide the community with the best possible services.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the building's mechanical systems are also outdated and in need of replacement, and staff do not have adequate space to store equipment or complete required trainings. The building does not have an adequate number of restrooms and is not compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act, making it inaccessible to many members of the community. Modernizing the existing building and adding the necessary square feet will make it a significantly more functional facility while supporting the retention and recruitment of staff.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized by 42 U.S. Code § 5305(a)(2).
