I am requesting funding for New Hampshire Statewide Rail Trail User Counting Network in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Rockingham Planning Commission, located at 156 Water Street, Exeter, NH 03833. The funding would be used for purchasing and installing 68 permanent counting sites on 35 rail trails across New Hampshire.
